Local health workers visited the college on 4 March to administer the De-worming drops to the students. On the same occasion, health workers counselled the girl students on personal hygiene and health.

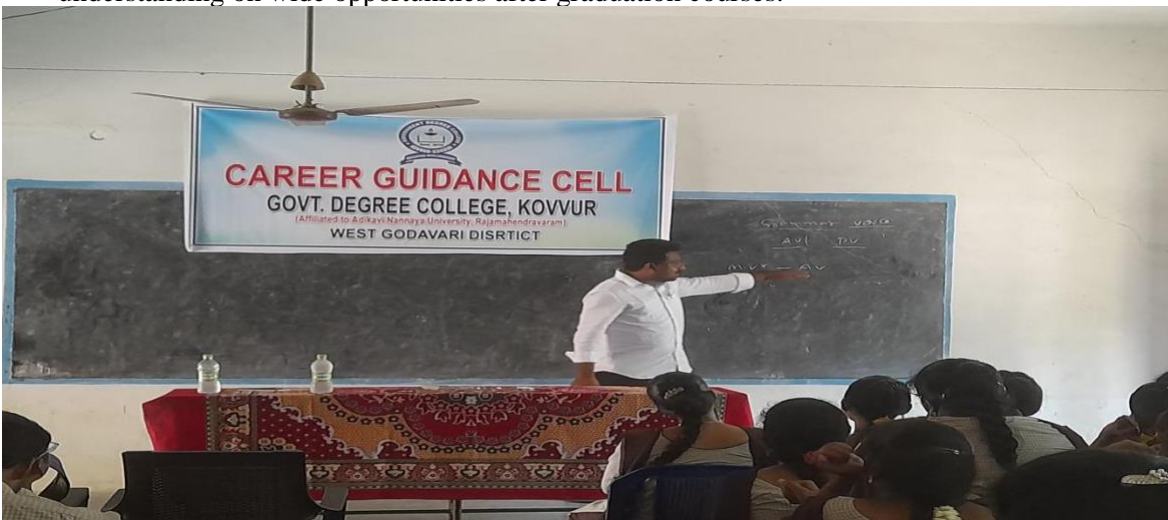

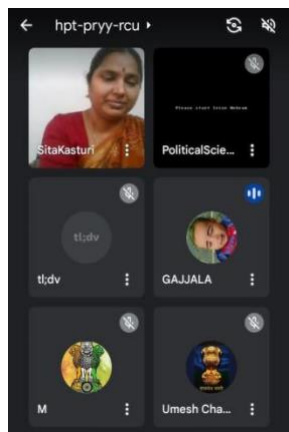
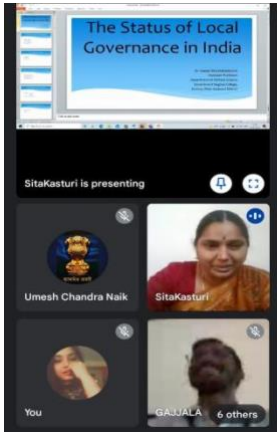

The sustainable development goals or the global goals are a collection of 17 SDGs designed to be a blueprint to achieve a better and more sustainable future for all. The SDGs are setup by the United Nations General Assembly (UNGA) and are intended to be achieved by 2030. They are included in the UNGA Resolutions called as 2030 Agenda and what is colloquially called as “AGENDA 2030”. These are designed to succeed the Millennium Development Goals which ended in 2015. The goals are broad and interdependent. The UNGA resolution identified specific targets for each goal along with indicators that are being used to measure progress towards each target. To facilitate monitoring, a variety of tools exist to track the progress towards the goals. The SDGs pay attention to multiple cross-cutting issues like the gender equality , education and culture, cut across all of the SDGs.
